Dover Adult Learning Center of Strafford County - DALC helps adults improve their lives through basic education, high school completion and enrichment classes throughout Strafford County. Between 2,500 and 3,000 people are served every year including 1,200 in literacy programs and 200 native speakers of other languages. Over 200 graduate with a high school credential each year.



Community Partners - A community mental health and developmental services provider for Strafford County, serving over 3,400 individuals annually. The agency provides comprehensive behavioral and developmental services for people of all ages.



HUB Family Resource Center - Dedicated to strengthening families by providing parent education and support services, enhancing their abilities to raise healthy children in caring homes. The HUB provides over 800 families annually with educational programs and support services. Over 600 of these families are at the Federal poverty level.

Monarch School of New England - The Monarch School provides a creative and unique educational and social environment to develop the lives and potential of students that are severely developmentally and physically disabled. They impact over 200 children, families, teachers and school administrators through their in-school and community programs.



Seymour Osman Community Center and Youth Safe Haven at Dover Housing Authority - A private non-profit youth safe haven/ police mini-station that provides youth and families with academic support, life skills training and recreational opportunities. "SOCC" helps children graduate from high school with a good work ethic, strong conflict resolution skills, clear goals for a better future and the confidence that they can achieve their goals.

With over 95% of the city's federally assisted housing sending their children to WPS, the school has the second highest percentage of such students in NH. Woodman Park PTO works hard to raise money to give every child opportunities they would otherwise not have.

Malley Farm Boy's Home - For 25 years, the Malley Farm Boys Home has been restoring safety, hope, trust and self-worth in the lives of children. Eighty percent (80%) of the seventeen residents are from families living below the poverty level.
